Hello and welcome to the 2009-10 Lea Sports PSG season review yearbook.

As you may be aware, the 2008-09 season was one of unprecedented success for the club, with promotions and cup finals for our teams at all levels. This meant that as we kicked off the 2009-10 season a lot of teams were competing in higher divisions.

Ed Thomson will step down as reserve team manager, Greg Nunn will step down as Under 15s' Manager, I will step down as Chairman and NHC Secretary and Robin O'Connell will be relinquishing his duties as CYL Secretary. Thanks to Ed, Greg and Robin for their efforts as always.

Finally, after an amazing 29 years service to the Club as a player, manager and committee member, Archie Conway has officially 'retired' after almost 650 games as a player – an amazing achievement at any level of football. Anyone who has played with Archie will know what an inspiration he is to those around him. A huge thanks must go to Archie for his devotion to the Club.

Please enjoy the awards evening and the rest of this yearbook, and good luck for season 2010-11.

A first-team regular in the mid-eighties, Archie has made most of his appearances for the Second string. A Vice-President of the Club, Archie was Second Team Manager between 2000 and 2003. Archie was Players' Player for the 1st XI in 1985-86, for the 2nds in 1991-92 and 1993-94 and for the Thirds in 1995-96 and 1996-97. He was also Manager's Player for the Seconds in 1993-94 and for the Thirds in 1997-98. He won the President's Award for the Reserves in 1989-90 and again the following year.</p> <p>He made his 600th appearance for the Club on 30th March 2008 in a Division 4 match vs. Dynamo Old Boys.</p>

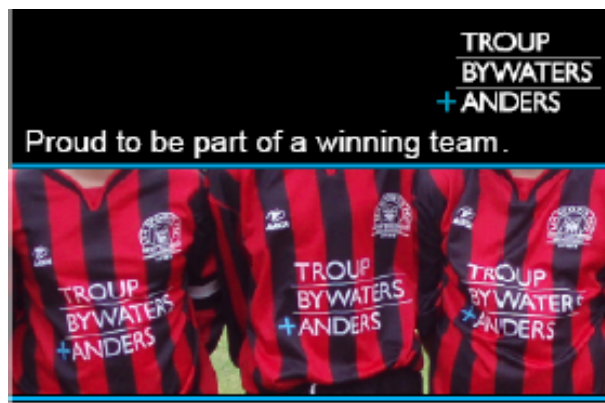

Season's Review

Steve Smith

This was always going to be a difficult season, after four of our teams gained promotion into higher divisions last year. All four teams found the going tough to begin with, but coped better as the season went on. Also, there were some remarkable results along the way for all of our teams.

The **First Team** found Division One a tough prospect and only won one league game before Christmas – and that was a rather fortunate 2-1 win over Lewsey Reserves. The prospects did not look good when the February fixtures gave us two away games against the 2 sides competing for the title: Four Horseshoes and Houghton Town. The 'Shoes game was amazing, with us conceding **four** penalties, two of which were converted, before we went down 5-3; but the following week we showed what we were capable of with a 3-2 win at Houghton Town – at that time their first defeat of the season. More consistent results followed with the best being the 2-0 win over Four Horseshoes in April, when we really did play them off the park. In the end a comfortable mid-table position from which we can build.

The **Reserves** were not overawed by their Division 3 opponents, but the very first game probably set the trend for the season: winning 2-0 at Lilley we ran out of steam late in the game and conceded late goals and a point. Some teams just turned out to be quicker and fitter than us. Mind you, there were some excellent performances, including a great County Cup run to the semi-finals and of course that final game at home to Markyate. Two weeks earlier we had visited Champions Markyate for a midweek game and were completely blown away: 7-0 down after 35 minutes and eventually defeated 8-1. Understandably, when Markyate turned up for the return game just 17 days later, flaunting the Division 3 Trophy, they thought it would be a walk in the park. How wrong they were as a first-half hat-trick from Phil Thompson rolled back the years. The onslaught continued in the second half and in the end the scoreline was, of course, an unbelievable 8-1 in our favour. It's a strange game sometimes.

The **Under Sixteens** joined us this year and asked to join the Chiltern Youth division 3 – so of course the league put them in division 2! A 1-0 win in their first game proved to be a false dawn as they only won 1 of their next 10 league games. Things did improve, however, and they reached the quarter-finals of the league cup and did the double over neighbours Shefford Saints. Probably the most amazing game was at home to Toddington Rovers when a 4-1 half-time lead turned into a nightmare 6-4 defeat after 90 minutes.

The **Under Fifteens** completed probably their final season with the Club after a 5-year stint in the Chiltern Youth highest division. In that time they have won the league cup and been pipped for the title twice, but this year's campaign proved to be one of the toughest. On their day they can still compete at the highest level, as draws with 3 of the top four teams showed and if this really is their last season with the Club they will be sorely missed.

The **Under Thirteens** probably had the toughest time of the promoted teams and failed to gain any points away from home in the league all season. Despite this they battled hard in every game and only twice did they concede more than 4 goals in any game. In the County Cup they were drawn at home to Sharnbrook Casuals but agreed to play away because of an Under 12 home tie on the same day. They must have treated it as a home game as they ran out 10-0 winners, followed by a 9-1 thrashing of Leighton United away in Round 2. Unfortunately, Round 3 brought a game against our Nemesis Crawley Green and the end of the run. In the end, the team learned a lot from this season and can look forward to next year with confidence.

The **Under Twelves** like the other teams got a shock in their first few games, losing heavily, but conscientious training and lots of effort saw them claw themselves to safety. Probably their best performance was away to Champions Crawley Green 'A' when we were winning 4-3 until conceding a late late equaliser. Despite the prospect of losing top scorer Curties O'Connell to the

Stevenage Academy, the team can look forward to further improvement next year, especially if Tom Boggon can stay injury-free!

The Mini-soccer teams also achieved some remarkable results in their respective campaigns.

The **Under Tens** were in with a shout of a runners-up spot until disappointment struck in the last two games. By far the most contentious game was the third round League Cup match against Bedford Panthers 'A'. We were losing 3-1 to the eventual runners-up in division 3, but managed to claw a goal back. Then with seconds to go the Bedford keeper dropped the ball on his line and despite his desperate efforts to grab the ball it was bundled into the net for an equaliser. The Bedford officials and supporters were furious that the goal had been allowed, although many watching thought that the keeper had lost control of the ball. In any event, the game went to penalties and we won through 2-1. Bedford even approached the league asking for the game to be replayed! Only goes to show that whatever level football is played at, passions run high.

The **Under Nines** finished in the top half, mainly thanks to the scoring exploits of Mini Golden Boot winner Louis Lomas and the steady goalkeeping of Reece Frankland. Their best performance came in November when they came back from 5-1 down to Sandy Colts to win 7-5, including five goals from Louis. I was glad to hear that the boys will be competing again at Under Ten next season.

The **Under Eights** performed above expectations, given that this was their first taste of league football. Big gaps in their fixture list didn't help matters and they couldn't maintain their early form, but results such as the 5-1 win over Sandy Colts show what promise there is in the side.

The end of any season always brings a few goodbyes and this is no exception. We wish the lads from the Under 15s well in whatever they decide to do. Best of luck too to their Manager Greg Nunn and coach Adrian Bell. Reserve Team Manager Ed Thomson is also stepping down this year after 7 successful years in charge to concentrate on his new family – best wishes to them. Chairman Greg Whelan has decided that he needs more time for his academic studies, so will give up his post too. Greg has taken the Chairman's role very seriously, always helping out when needed and giving the Club a steady hand on the tiller. My thanks go to him for his work over the past four years.

Unbelievably, Archie Conway's playing days have come to an end after nearly 30 years with the Club and 640 games. I'm not going to say goodbye, as I can't imagine Archie will sever his links with the Club and I'm sure we'll see him at some games and Committee Meetings yet.

As for me: I'm about to start my 34th year with the Club after humble beginnings at the old Teachers' Centre in the centre of Luton. There have been many changes in that time: the merger with Stopsley Boys Club; four strong Sunday adult sides in the nineties; an unsuccessful foray into ladies' football, the move to Pirton and of course more recently the merger with Shillington & Gravenhurst United and the development of mini-soccer.

Lea Sports has never been a Club at the pinnacle of the local game: (our First Team has only spent one season in the Premier League of the North Home Counties), but the Club has a well-established name and reputation as being a well-run and friendly Club which does things the right way. I've known many youth players who have left us to move to more 'successful' clubs, but I've also known many who have returned because they like what Lea Sports has to offer. At the time of writing I don't know the outcome of the vote to change the Club's name to 'Pirton FC'. We are now firmly established as the village football team and in some ways the actual name is not that important. SECOND TEAM REPORT – Ed Thomson

This season has proved a mixed bag, in which we have won 6, drawn 5 and lost 7.

A couple of the lost games could very easily have been won and we would have finished amongst the top 4-5 in the division. So, having been promoted from Div 4 last season, this season has proved a good grounding for another push for promotion next season.

I know that the lads (well, most of them!) were certainly looking forward to trying their hand against stronger opposition than we have faced before.

A couple of new additions to the squad emerged from pre-season training this year: **Scott Ayres**, who has settled into the centre of defence, and **Jonny Gray**, who can play across the defence and midfield. **Jack Baggett** has also made the step up from U18 level and has provided an attacking option.

This season has given us the opportunity to meet and play against some familiar opposition, such as Lilley, Hexton and Co-Op; and also the challenge of the unknown – teams such as USL Red Star and Markyate. Against Lilley and Hexton, we were able to play pretty comfortable football, the sort that we played whilst going unbeaten last year. On the other hand, in USL Red Star and Markyate we were facing really hungry opponents, who were playing attacking football whilst also being strong defensively, something which we knew we would have to face at the higher level of football.

Once more, we managed to reach two cup semi-finals – the County Cup and the Reserves Cup. The County Cup saw us get good away wins in Leighton Buzzard and Clifton, whilst we managed to beat Celtic Res away in the Res Cup. Unfortunately we didn't quite have it in us to go all the way to either final.

Markyate proved interesting opposition to us this year. In an April midweek game they smashed us 8-1, leading 7-0 at half time. And two weeks later in the return fixture we beat them by the same score line (though only leading 3-1 at half time). They didn't look best pleased.

The two outstanding games this season came against Co-Op and USL Red Star. Both teams had beaten us at their grounds, so came to Pirton looking to roll us over again. Co-Op went into the lead 1-0, 2-1, 3-2, only for us to beat them 4-3. All 4 of our goals that day were contenders for goal of the season! Even they admitted it was one of the best games they had played in. Against USL Red Star, they forged into a 3-1 lead with 20 mins left, only for us to get back via a Ben Thomson penalty and a Jack Baggett screamer with just 3 mins left. They too weren't best pleased, as it blew their own chance of promotion.

Finally, I'd like to thank all the players who have played for me whilst I have been manager for the last 7 years. I have thoroughly enjoyed it all.

It has been a real pleasure managing this team over the years and as a result I have many happy memories to look back on as I am sure the boys & parents do too.

I would like to give a big thank you to Adrian for his enthusiasm as he coaches and organises the boys on match days and takes coaching session when Wayne is unable. Also a big thank you to Wayne for his coaching and match day input, his experience & passion for the game is something we are lucky to have the benefit of. Thanks to all the parents for their help and support this and previous seasons. Most of all thanks to the boys, I hope they have enjoyed playing football here as much as we have enjoyed watching them.
