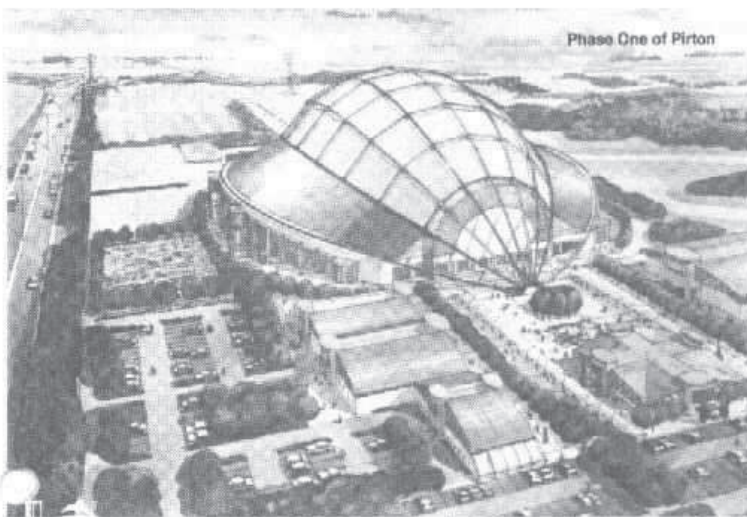

Soccer Club fights for Smith-a-Drome

BATTLE lines are being drawn up by opposing sides of the village over plans to build Lea Sports FC a new home in a £30m space-age leisure complex in Pirton. Tory council candidates for the area have pledged to fight it. Thousands of football fans are lined up to back it. And in what might be the most crucial fight of all, early peace moves were under way yesterday between soccer club chairman Keith Lee and Pirton Manor, owners of the land, who have so far refused to deal with him.

Lea Sports PSG FC - 2014 – 2015

The 2014-15 Season was a very successful one for our adult Saturday team and for our Under Seventeens. By contrast, both Sunday adult sides had very difficult seasons, with the First XI in particular having an awful campaign, conceding three games and winning just four league points all season. The Reserves too looked to be carrying on where they left off last season – losing games – but they rallied later in the season with some good cup performances in particular, and a final tally of 14 league points.

In June 2014 we thought we would have two adult Saturday teams: AFC Shillington had approached us to play under the Lea Sports PSG name. They had finished third in the Premier Division of the Beds. County League and looked to be a well-run club with a good management team and an excellent chance of winning honours. The pre-season discussions went well and we enrolled the team in the league, along with a new team to play as our Reserves in Division 3. Then, one day in July after training, the Manager decided he was giving up and walked away – all of a sudden we were left with just a Division 3 side and fines from the League and County FA for withdrawing so late. Fortunately the Division 3 team did the Club proud, finishing as runners-up and reaching one Cup Final and one semi-final.

The Under Seventeens recovered from a slightly shaky start, when they were presented with a very tough County Cup draw against St. Albans City EJA team and some difficult opening league fixtures, to eventually finish in third place in the Chiltern Youth Under Seventeen Division 1 – a great performance and one which we hope they will build on next year. Finally, in the 11 vs.11 format, we ran a team at Under 14, but they struggled for a goalkeeper and goals in the early part of the season and, although they won a couple of friendly matches, they achieved just 1 point in the league and generally struggled.

The mini-soccer scene was generally a good one, although the Under 12 Tigers found goalscoring very difficult and managed just 23 all season, with Noah Nyoni top scoring again with just 9 goals. For the Under 11 age group we ran two sides: the Cougars on Sundays and the Fishercats on Saturdays. The Cougars had an odd set of fixtures, with 2 mini-leagues and a set of friendly fixtures from the Chiltern Youth League. They finished mid-table in the first mini-league, runners-up in the second, before losing all the 'friendly league' fixtures. The Fishercats played well throughout the season and had high hopes of finishing as runners-up to the runaway Champions Sundon Athletic Whites. In the end, a couple of narrow defeats at the wrong stage of the season saw them slip to fourth place, but a worthy effort nonetheless. At Under 9 the Jaguars played on Sunday mornings. They had to wait until late October for their first win and relied heavily all season on the great skills and goalscoring prowess of Samuel Bayley (28 goals in 21 games). Meanwhile, the Under 7 Lions made their debut and enjoyed their season, even though they did end up playing the same teams a number of times, which was not always the most enjoyable experience. The Club will do its best next season to try and get the Jaguars and Lions into leagues which more equally match their abilities, so the players can get the most from the season.

Last but not least, our Saturday morning sessions for 4-6 year olds have gone from strength to strength, with over 20 players turning up most Saturdays. We hope this will lead to a new Under 7s team again next season.

Finally, a big thank you to everyone who has helped the Club run this season: managers, coaches, mums and dads and our great 'kitchen staff'. It's you who make the Club what it is.

My thanks go again to Phil Toyer the Team's Coach. Also a big thank you to Paul Condon who stepped in at short notice on several occasions to referee some of our home games early in the season.
