Lea Sports Football Club was created ten years ago to give Junior School Teachers the opportunity to demonstrate their prowess on the green and pleasant lands within Luton. With youthful exuberance a 'friendly' side donned their yellow and black stripes and 'buzzed' enthusiastically, and sometimes purposefully, on numerous Sundays during that first season.

From this modest beginning the club has developed and expanded. During the more recent seasons three sides have regularly graced the public pitches in the area, two playing league football and one playing on a friendly basis.

Numerous friendships have developed, innumerable memories and apocryphal tales have accumulated and if the success of the club is to be measured I would point to these achievements as the yardstick upon which we should base our judgements.

HAPPY MEMORIES.

I suppose that working with computers it is only natural that I should find statistics fascinating. It has been an enjoyable task for me, therefore, to compile this history of Lea Sports F.C., which I hope will stir a few memories. Unfortunately, many of the early records have disappeared and I am indebted to Kelvin Callow, Bruce Bonfield, Ivan Lawrence and Phil Clarke for coming up with the information enclosed.

Some of the figures do make interesting reading, for example, the Club's record win was the 15-2 cup defeat of Hollybush in 1975-6 (in which Mick Stead scored 9 times), the worst defeat was the third's 0-13 hammering at the hands of the unlikely-named Cherry Blossom United in late 1980. The biggest League defeat was the second's 1-11 reverse against The Oaks Reserves in 1977-8 (Jim Gahagan won't thank me for reminding him that he was in goal at the time).

Actually, Jim has figured in some of the funnier moments, such as when taking a short goal-kick to himself during a cup-tie in October 1981, or arranging to take a short goal-kick with Keith Lee, upon which they put the ball down and both ran to the edge of the box! Then there was the goal-kick that actually went straight to Steve Crick - who was standing, arms folded, watching the game on the next pitch. Talking of spectators, we did actually draw a fair crowd for one game, but at one point somebody noticed that they were all standing with their backs to us watching a neighbouring game. We have all, however, been inspired by the support from our own players at times, such as Jim Gahagan's exhortations to "kick the one in the red socks" (they were all playing in red socks) or Mick Meehan's remarks on Jim Halls' fitness to take penalty kicks, which are, I'm afraid, unprintable. And when Ade Duke broke his ankle was it really by kicking a post whilst scoring an own goal? Or do you believe his story?.

Anyway, I hope you will enjoy the figures herein - there certainly are some names to conjure with, and I hope you will treasure it as I do, as a book full of happy memories.

May the Club continue to prosper and may its tradition continue for many years to come.

FIRST TEAM REPORT 1982 - 1983

A VIEW ON THIS SEASON

The pre-season training should have prepared us for the coming League and Cup fixtures, but no matter how much you practise a skill or a move you can never account for Luck. I say this because I believe that this season was changed by Luck.

The Luck in, or in fact the lack of it, when we played Housing Social, a Division 7 side, in the Luton News Cup. This was a game which we were entering with a lot of confidence - a game which would give us a semi-final place and do our morale no harm for the battles ahead.

But we came across something which cancelled out our superiority entirely and that was of all things the weather.

We have never been the best team battling against the elements, but this particular Sunday we were stopped in our tracks.

I think I can speak for most of the players when I say it was the worst conditions ever encountered on a football pitch.

The wind was gusting to gale force and coupled with torrential rain this made the whole game a lottery, which unfortunately we lost 2 - 0. After the game players were nearly in a state of collapse and in fact reading in later editorials it stated that not only were most games cancelled but some that were foolishly started resulted in players collapsing from what was described as hypothermia and exposure.

I think after this game because of our bad Luck the season changed, I am not saying we collapsed, because this had certainly been an above average season but I believe we could have gained not only a cup final place but possibly promotion.

Apart from this game, though, there have been many splendid games and excellent performances from all players including Phil Clarke's and Mick Meehan's goal scoring prowess. Solid defence work by Kevin Tye, Dave Blake, John Darley, Kelvin Callow and Jim Halls (Vice Captain). Midfield artistry and spectacular goals from Gary Eccles and Al Mayman who with Phil Thompson have been the two new players to establish themselves this year. Phil Hudspeth and Jim Cahagan have kept goal and us in the game. On the wings Mick Marsh and Kevin Newsome have supplied many a good cross and goal. There has been such good support from all the subs and administrators also.....

BUSMEN GO FOR TREBLE

LUTON'S BUSMEN went roaring on towards their treble goal in Sunday soccer when they made sure of the first leg, the Bedfordshire Sunday Lower Junior Cup, with a well-deserved victory over Lea Sports, the local junior school-teachers' side, at Electrolux.

Next stops for United Counties on route to success will be to try to clinch the North Home Counties Sunday League's Division V championship, and then SKF-UK in the League's Luton News Cup Final.

An all-action, hard-running side, they took capable of pulling it off, but they will need to snap up scoring chances with more alacrity than they showed on Sunday when their lead looked none too secure as Lea made a spirited fight-back in the last 10 minutes.

The schoolmasters missed the bus in the fifth minute when they had the chance to take the lead through a penalty. The experienced John Ashworth at the heart of the Counties' defence

should have known better than to haul down Alvin Goodwin in the area in full view of referee Ron Wilson of Houghton Regis.

Michael Briggs stepped up to take the kick and United Counties goalkeeper Ray Mulford could hardly believe his luck when Briggs put a tame shot straight at him.

The chance came from an isolated break by nippy little Goodwin in the midst of some concerted first half pressure by the busmen who threatened to make the final very much one-way traffic.

Bernie Mapp, who has delighted in his games for Counties as a light relief

from life in senior soccer on Saturdays with Milton Keynes, looked a cut above the rest, as was to be expected and did a good job as midfield general.

Twice in the first half he opened up the Lea defence to send Neil McPherson clear, only for the Counties' big striker to let Lea off the hook by finishing badly.

On numerous other occasions the busmen's forward push was halted by the timely intervention of Lea's star defender, Michael Stead, who demonstrated considerable skill in covering the gaps and playing the teachers out of trouble.

It was not until the 37th minute that the Lea defence finally surrendered to the pressure. Martin Spooner floated over a corner from the right for Neil McPherson to head goalwards, Ivan Lawrence in the Lea goal made a terrible hash of trying to punch clear and only succeeded in helping McPherson's header into the net.

For the third time Mapp put it on a plate for McPherson, who missed an easy chance to add a second for Counties before the interval by shooting wide.

There was considerable improvement by Lea Sports after the interval when they did a lot more attacking. But more often than not the industry of Alvin Goodwin who buzzed everywhere in search of an equaliser was given little support by his colleagues.

The busmen increased

their lead midway through the half through a brilliant goal by Bernie Mapp. Again it was his understanding with McPherson that created the danger as he sent the striker racing through a gap with a good pass.

McPherson was in a good position to have a go himself, but elected to return the compliment for Mapp who had run over to his right in support, and Bernie took the ball on to score with an angled drive.

With 10 minutes to go Lea found the man they needed to lift their sagging spirits when substitute Chris Castle came on to boost their strength up the middle with some powerful running and put them right back into the game with a neat lob over the head of Ray Mulford.

They may well have gone on to force extra time as for the first time the Counties' defence looked distinctly uneasy. Lea came close to snatching an equaliser on two occasions when the Counties' defence were lucky to block a shot by Phil Clarke and Chris Castle headed just over the bar a fine inswinging corner by Alvin Goodwin.

United Counties were thankful to hold out for the final whistle with their slender advantage intact.
