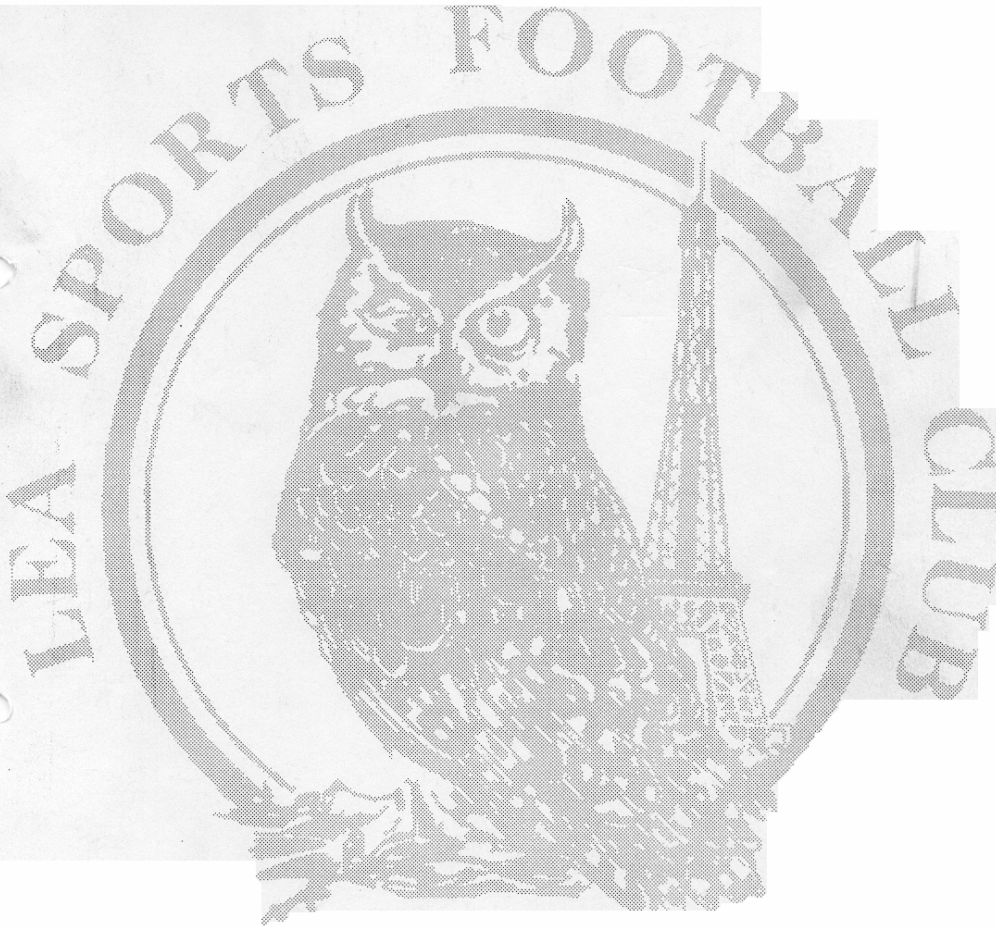

## First Team Report

Another season done and dusted! What was so different about this one? Well, this season produced the highest league position of any. Lea Sports Football team in its twenty year history – fifth place in Division 2.

At the start of the season there was great hope that we could recreate our previous season's performances and gain promotion and to begin with there was some reason to believe that dreams do come true.

Our early confidence was gained by starting the season with four cup games, punctuated by one league game, all with favourable results although one of these was a defeat.

Sounds strange, but the defeat was against mighty AFC Wheels in the Whitbread Cup First Round. After winning through in the prelim round against FC Houghton at the second attempt, we relished the opportunity to play Premier Division opposition. And what a game we played, holding Wheels until extra time when they squeezed a 1-0 win. This again proved that Lea at their best are capable of better things.

Although this was a grand start, in the second game of the season we lost the team captain Alan Dawson with a serious ankle injury. Strength in depth allowed us to overcome, with the pairing of Pete Mather and Trev Taylor linking well at the back and Kevin Connolly appointed as captain.

Our biggest shortcoming of the season and probably our undoing in the league was our inability to turn in consistent performances. This was best demonstrated by great showings in cup matches followed the week after by poor showings in the league.

Having said that, you can't always have your cake and eat it; I would not have missed the cup matches against Wheels and Stopsley Harriers for the world. Stopsley Harriers, the game where we not only played good opposition but also beat them resoundingly. A game where tactics paid off (it doesn't happen that often), playing three at the back and pushing five into midfield completely baffled them, allowing us to score two goals through Andy Shiers early on. Running out eventual winners 3-1, I enjoyed it so much I even gave Ted Ellis a hug.

Ted (coach) certainly deserves a mention for his dedication to the team throughout the year, but also for his amazing determination to support the team even after having not one but two heart attacks. Look after yourself Ted.

Support from the touchline is a very important ingredient that in previous seasons we have lacked, but this year has seen a hard core braving all weathers. I can't possibly mention you all, but I would like to thank Maurice Dawson and all the people who supplied me and others with coffee.



Back to football, our cup run ended sadly against The Oaks in the Quarter Finals of the Sunday Junior Cup, with the controversial sending-off of Andy Shiers leaving a sour taste in our mouths.

Referees have a hard job and I applaud them, but we have faced many strange decisions this year and the higher you go the weirder they become. The funniest on reflection was the decision to cancel the game against Brewery because of an icy pitch, the Ref was hilarious testing out the pitch.

The worst decisions during the year in my book are the ones which allow thugs to get away with murder, one incident ending Kevin Connolly's season prematurely with a shin injury. We all hate injuries and the whole team was glad to see Rick Vipers, who had claimed the right-back position for his own, make a full recovery from bad facial injuries sustained during an away game at Caddington. Flying Andy Sheridan, the dirtiest player in Lea Sports (kit-wise that is) was called up and performed well.

Our league season continued like a roller coaster, one minute it looked like we were going down and the next it looked like we could possibly go up. A new captain was appointed, keeper Graham Hunt taking control, Alan Dawson returned to the team in January, hope was blossoming.

The early part of 1992 saw us struggle to convert our chances, continually letting teams off the hook, drawing rather than winning. The inclusion of the evergreen Phil Clarke in the team briefly gave us the Midas touch again. Linking well with Phil Thompson in a fantastic display against Brewery, we ensured we would not be relegated and the whole team showed that we are at our happiest playing fast, flowing football.

The glimmer of promotion was extinguished in two defeats in succession, against Wyvern and then against Vauxhall Hightown, the latter our most frustrating performance of the season. The last throes of the season saw us take three points from the last two games and left us all reflecting on what might have been.

Some may say the season was a disappointment after our herculean efforts of the previous year, but the higher you go the harder it gets, so this year represented a milestone and an achievement of which every team and Club member should be proud.

I would like to thank all the players who played for the first time this year, it was nice to see some new faces coming through. Mick Justin adding strength to our midfield, Andy Shiers who played in nearly every position and Martin Watt who showed great promise. The old heads were still there and justifiably so: Paul Gather, Pete Mather, Al Mayman. Our forward presence was provided by Phil Thompson and Kev Boxall (top goalscorer), ably supported in midfield by Russell Sheppard, Keith Downing, Steve Close and Kevin Connolly, my M.o.M. for the season. Trev Taylor was the outstanding player in defence.

Thanks go to Steve Smith for the pile of information provided during the season and thanks to the Second Team for an enjoyable 1st vs 2nd match.

This is my last year as manager and I would like to wish my successor every success and I hope that the foundations are now in place to establish our Club as one of the best in the town, not only for its standard of football, but also for its attitude to its Members and to other clubs.

## Second Team Report

We've had a good year. And it could easily have been better still, but for some enforced team changes which disrupted us for a few weeks.

The campaign started on a warm September day against Casa Bianca at Lothair Road. We led 1-0 until the last couple of minutes, when we gave away a goal and a point. In the end we did that too often, drawing seven games - more than anyone else in the division. Funnily enough, the season ended in much the same way - we conceded a very late goal and a point to Stopsley Harriers Reserves.

Anyway, back in September, the ridiculous set of fixtures we had to contend with meant that we played Casa Bianca 3 times in 5 weeks, including a Luton News Cup win. Unfortunately, Casa did not live up to their early form and many teams had easier games against them later.

Our first loss came in October, a 2-1 defeat at Borough Arms Reserves, who eventually finished one point ahead of us. Leading 1-0 at half-time, we all knew it was a game we shouldn't have lost. Nevertheless, by the end of October, our only other defeat was a narrow 2-0 loss in the Reserve Cup to Wyvern, who eventually ran out Champions of division two.

Then, in November, things took a turn for the worse. We had a nightmare cup game against division 6 Black Swan, losing 6-0. What we didn't realise at the time was that Steve Lewis's injury was worse than we thought and we were not to see him again!

After Steve we were to use a further six goalkeepers! Alan Dawson did a great job for us for a few games and my thanks go to him and to the other keepers who helped us out: Ali Hearn, Steve Davies, Pete Mather, Graham Hunt and Derrick Leather. Add to this the changes in the centre of defence in particular and you can see the problems we had to face. No less than 11 people have played in the two central defender positions.

Anyway, of the seven games before Christmas, we won one, drew three and lost in each of the three cup competitions. I was quite happy when the game against British Rail on 15th December was postponed because of frost.

The first two games of 1992 put us back on track, with two great wins over promotion rivals Borough Arms Reserves (3-1) and Wells Star (2-1). This latter win in particular was very pleasing, since Wells Star were in a winning streak and are never easy to beat at home. Two more good wins against Luton British Rail were to follow, before a disastrous day in the pouring rain against Riley's. I won't elaborate.

We were still top, though, and killed off another challenger in a fine win against second-placed Roman Legion. Caddington Reserves and Stopsley Harriers Reserves had many games in hand however and our home game with Caddington on 1st March was to provide our only home league defeat of the season. We dominated for an hour, but the score was still 0-0. Twenty minutes later we were 5-0 down and our challenge was over.

Caddington and Harriers were by now playing many midweek games and weren't having too many problems with team selection. Also, they were playing teams whose seasons in the main were over and they weren't meeting much resistance. Take for example Caddington vs. Roman Legion. This match was abandoned in January with Legion winning 2-0. In March, Legion's challenge was over and they lost the rearranged match 6-0, fielding just nine men.

Our season ended with three creditable performances against Caddington (1-1), and Harriers twice, losing 3-2 to a 'disputed' penalty and that final 2-2 draw.

We finished fourth, but with the best league record of any Lea Sports Reserve side, taking just under 66% of the points available. We only lost 4 league games: one each to the three teams above us and one to Riley's! And no team did the double over us.

Special mentions for four people, although everyone deserves credit for this season: Charlie McNerney, who started the season as Captain, but decided to hang up his boots around Christmas (funny, most people hang up stockings!); Pete Conquest, who was playing some of his best football until a knee injury against Riley's ruined his season; Phil Clarke, top scorer once again and last but not least Archie Conway whose captaincy and commitment have been an inspiration for us all.

Thanks to everyone who helped me out on the pitch (especially Ali Hearn when I dragged him out of 'retirement' - and bed - to play in goal against British Rail). Many thanks to groundsman Ted Lindsay for looking after us so well again. Thanks to all the substitutes. Thanks to the supporters who stood in the rain with me. And to hell with Riley's.

## Secretary's Report

They say success comes at a price - unfortunately this was literally true for us. Having won the Division Three championship last year we proudly put the cup in the trophy cabinet and then forgot all about it - until we got fined for not returning it to the league! We have now learned our lesson and engraved and returned the trophy. I'm sure we won't forget next time...

Each year I try to think of different things to put in this report (and each year it gets harder). I thought that this year, since I can no longer play, I would look back at my own debut for Lea Sports in early December 1977 (was it really 15 years ago?)

Charlie McNerney and I were the 'big signings' from S.C.Luton ('Supporters Club Luton' - the forerunners of Royal Oak, now Stopsley WMC). Our first match was a Division 4 game vs. Nesco, which we won 3-2. I went on to play 12 games that season, including a 3-2 win over Stopsley WMC and a 5-2 win over AFC Wheels. Other matches were against teams such as Bluebirds, Dunstable Rosedale, Firenza and Waterlows - where are they now?

For the record, the team in that Nesco game was:

Ivan Lawrence, Mick Briggs, Don North, Andy Thompson,  
Chris Castle, Ali Hearn, Wojtek Gabrys, Steve Castleman,  
Andy Walker, Charlie and myself.

The match was one of those rare occasions when Phil Clarke was a substitute! Goalscorers were Wojtek (2) and, of course, Phil Clarke.

This season has provided a few interesting facts: the fourth team's win at Wrest Park on 26th April 1992 was the Club's 500th win, whilst the next draw will be the Club's 200th. All three teams finished in their highest league positions ever and as a whole the Club scored 49 goals more than last season.

On 2nd February 1992 all three teams kept a clean sheet (1st XI vs Brewery 0-0, 2nd XI vs Luton British Rail 3-0 and 3rd XI vs Independent 17-0, equalling the club record score). I can find no other day since 1973 when all three teams have conceded no goals.

The second team scored in each one of their 22 league games this season. Again I can find no other season where this has happened. Overall, the second team had their best season ever, taking 61.3% of available points.

On 8th September 1991, the First XI won 5-0 vs. FC Houghton, the Second XI won 4-1 vs. Luton YS and the Third XI won 7-0 vs. Independent, a total of 16 goals. The thirteenth of these 16 goals was the 3,000th scored by Lea Sports F.C. I wonder who scored it?



Some of you may remember the item in last year's magazine about playing the Champions in our last game – this year the Second and Third teams continued the tradition! (Second XI vs Stopsley Harriers Res, Third XI vs Strawplaiters). The First team played champions Wyvern Reserves twice in their last 4 games.
