# Secretary's Report

This has been a season full of incident for Lea Sports Football Club. The season started with our Summer 5-a-side tournament. This attracted a large number of teams, but also a large number of arguments, to which the lack of referees was a major contributory factor. Most of the arguments centred around members of our Saturday team and at the subsequent Committee meeting the decision was taken to expel them from the Club. I am sure that everyone involved is convinced we made the right decision.

The low point was the decision to withdraw the First Team from the North Home Counties Premier Division; especially for those of us who have struggled for many years to attain that status. A number of players decided to leave last summer for the 'greener grass' of Luton Old Boys and this left us short of players with adequate experience. Also, there were some players who were happy in the Reserves and did not relish the thought of playing in the First Team. Put both these factors together and you have a First Team that is struggling for players. I know that Mark Kempton tried very hard to keep the team going and I thank him for his efforts. It was a great blow to all of us to see the team withdrawn.

The thirds and fourths both had good seasons in the South Beds League, finishing third and fourth respectively. The Thirds also made it through to the Division One final, where they lost a very close match 2-1 to Purley Old Boys.

Next year, of course, the Reserves become the First Team, the Thirds will become the Reserves and the Fourth will become the Thirds. We are also pleased to welcome a new side who will fill our Fourth Team slot in the South Beds Division 2. One sad point is that Kev Knight has resigned from his managerial job. He has had some very successful seasons with the Fourth and we all thank him very much for his efforts.

The Youth banner has been carried admirably by the Under 14 Reds this year. Until their last league game, they had dropped only one league point and had the Championship in the bag. (I think in the last game at home to Amptill it all went to their heads and they let slip a 5-2 lead to lose 5-6!). Ironically, apart from one game I refereed, I only saw them play twice all season and they lost both those games! They were also League Cup semi-finalists, losing 5-3 to Bushmead, so all in all a great season.

The Blues, by comparison, lived up to their name and only won one league game all season – although it was by an 8-1 margin.

The Under 11's found it hard going against the tougher opposition in Division One. Nevertheless they did achieve some great results, including a draw against Champions Celtic in a game they very nearly won, and a 4-0 win over last season's Division Two champions EBE Lions. I am sure the team will have learnt from this season and will emerge stronger next year.

Next year we look forward to having a Saturday team again – Steve Blackhurst is bringing the Luton TC side over to play as Lea Sports. Since the team's management and some of its players are well known to us I am sure that we will have none of the problems we had with Hitchin Reds and I am looking forward to an interesting season.

A top four finish in our first season in the South Beds Division 2 I think represents a good season. As per usual we struggled for players despite moving away this season from the "Friendly" League. The standard of football this year was better.

I thank Dave Malvern for his help finding players, Alan Bleeks and Victor Chiew came through the ranks to be permanent members. In December however, we lost Paul Dubal (went to live abroad) and Al Palmer (injury).

Despite not having a regular goalkeeper for the early part of the season, Mark Stevens joined us in November and he proved to be a great asset. An example of our struggle: Craig Brooke our top goal scorer started in goal against Yeoman, came out on the pitch with 10 minutes to go and scored the winner whilst Eddie Johnson who took over from him pulled off a great save which earned us the points. We played that day with 10 men.
