President's Report

So here we are at the end of Lea Sports' 29th Season of League football. It is a credit to all the teams and their managers that the Club achieved some notable successes at the end of a season which began with many problems off the field.

Following my decision to resign as Secretary last May, Dave Lindley also decided to stand down from the Chairman's position, which left a vacuum on the Executive Committee. Running a Club this size needs a lot of effort off the pitch - to raise funds, mark pitches, collect subs, organise social events, collect results and liaise with the various leagues and the Hertfordshire FA. The Club can consider itself very lucky that Keith Lee agreed to step in as Chairman and to pursue the task with such commitment. Not only has he represented the Club on the Pirton Sports and Social Club Committee, but he has dealt with the 'troublesome third team' and generally pulled the Club together.

This means that the Club is once again in a strong position to achieve success on the pitch. I look forward in particular to the new Youth sides proposed for next season (at Under 12) and we hope very much that the core of last season's Under 16 Reds will form the basis of a new Third Team to play adult football on Sunday mornings. It was always the aim that the better youth players would make the transition from our Youth teams into our own adult teams, instead of playing until Under 16 then moving on to other adult Clubs. I realise that for this to happen our adult sides have to be successful to offer them football of a worthy standard. This is now the case again, with the success of the First Team and the Saturday side and I hope more and more youth players will come through the ranks.

Once again we have shown that it's not all about winning silverware: the Under Sixteen Blues found themselves in the wrong division and finished bottom, but they had a committed squad of players throughout and we hope that they managed to enjoy their campaign. We also ran a second string on Saturdays for the first time and although this team also finished bottom of their division, we hope they provided a buffer of players for the Saturday first team which helped them to their Cup Final success.

The Club has changed a good deal since our move to Pirton in the mid-1990s, but we must concentrate on the spirit and togetherness which makes the Club strong. I hope all who read this will continue to enjoy their time with Lea Sports for many years to come.

Under Sixteen Reds Report

Votes for Players' Player of the Year have been collected - the vote was very close and the winner is - TAL KANG.

The Manager's choice for Player of the Year goes to - ADAM COX.

Top goalscorer is once again BEN L'HONORÉ.

The season got off to a slow start for us and with only a small squad we found it very hard to set a pattern for our play. The team started with 16 players signed on, but with only a couple of games played this reduced to 12. We gave several players turns in goal and credit must go to those players who helped out whilst we sorted out a new keeper. The squad performed well and showed good character, staying high in the league for most of the season. Having an ineligible player play in a match against us which we lost 1-0 could have been the turning point in our league season.

We had joined the ROYSTON CROW LEAGUE and we felt it would be a good challenge for our Club. The league however was found to be slow and I feel the communication to clubs is very poor. Trying to get a referee was also a job and a half. I found that trying to get a settled training routine was impossible, with only half the players being able to make the sessions. The age of the players meant that some had work commitments or schoolwork, which was more important. This showed towards the end of the season when our performance dropped. Several key decisions didn't go our way and the team confidence dropped. It is hard to motivate players when they feel things just aren't going their way.

The league was also a problem for the distances we had to travel to matches, some journeys of between 70 and 80 miles round trip. The parents who helped me make the journeys to away matches deserve praise: Stewart Wilkie, Saune and Neaula Duggan didn't miss a match.

Our League Cup performance against Shefford Saints was a game to remember. In conditions which could only be described as terrible, with winds gusting up to 40 mph, I feel the true spirit of the team showed through. Following a run of three games where luck had not been with us, the team fought well and showed they had a strong will to win. Dominating most of the game through hard work saw some class goals thump into the visitors' net. A memorable 25-yard drive from Simon White started a convincing performance. Goals followed from Ben L'Honoré, Danny Duggan and Ross Prentice giving us a 4-0 half-time lead. However, in our last match against Shefford Saints we had squandered a 4-1 lead, only to win 6-5 with virtually the last kick of the game. We knew we had the wind against us and a team that could come back if we gave them any chance.

We gave away a free kick on the edge of the penalty area early in the second half. Shefford had a powerful shot deflected into our net by Tal Kang. He acknowledged the goal with a salute to the rest of his team mates.

Lea's spirit was not thrown: they still pushed forward and were rewarded with another goal. Then, after putting on a substitute whose first act was to give away a penalty, I feared we might have cooked our goose. It was left to a goal from Ben L'Honoré which was applauded all around the ground to restore the team's comfortable lead. It was one of his many goals for the side this season and one which will be remembered for the high level of skill he showed, juggling the ball three times before shooting into the bottom corner of the net, leaving the goalkeeper rooted to the spot. The final score of 6-2 was one of the best performances from the team I have seen this season. They were a credit to themselves and to the Club.

The Cup performances were without doubt the highlight of our season. We were drawn against Risdon Wood Athletic at the Recreation Ground. Having drawn 2-2 the week before in a league match we felt we could do well at home. The match got off to a great start for us with Richard Knock hitting a 25-yard curling shot into the visitors' net after only two minutes. Risdon drew level with a hotly-disputed penalty just before half-time. However, in the second half we showed great resolve and Richard Knock hit three more. We left the visitors shell-shocked with another excellent team performance.

In the League Cup Final we were drawn against Stevenage Colts - a team we have never beaten. The game at Royston Town under floodlights was well-supported, with over 125 people there to cheer on the teams. Lea took the lead with a header from Tal Kang, but we fell behind to two quick goals to go into half-time trailing 2-1. Little did we know what was going to happen in the second half. Shortly after the kick-off we were level again, with another header from Tal Kang. With 15 minutes to go Ben L'Honoré put us into the lead. The side held on with some great saves from Chris Gear until into injury time, when Stevenage Colts forced the ball into the Lea net. The players - desperately tired and sore from the game - had to ready themselves again for another twenty minutes extra time.

In the first period of extra time, Richard Knock was brought down in the penalty area. Adam Cox took his time and hit the back of the Colts' net. We were willing the side to hold on and all was going well, but the ref just kept going. Two minutes into injury time in the second period of extra time Stevenage again drew level at 4-4. The match was now to be decided on penalties. With Chris Gear sidelined with a knee injury, Adam Cox took over in goal and the teams exchanged shots. It came down to the last two kicks and Lea had finally been beaten 3-2 in the shoot-out.

This was our greatest performance and all credit to the players for taking the League Champions and County Champions to the wire in the League Cup - a wonderful experience. A fitting time to retire from youth football as Manager. Thank you for the past seven years, thank you for all the support and the endless hours of kit-washing, training, travelling and committee meetings.
